

Robindra Jayanthi:

The birth of this noble man needs great attention and we must learn from his simple life and global thinking. He is a source of beauty and knowledge and as the inspiration of all noble thought and great ideas. He was born on 07th May 1861 at Kolkata, for Maharishi Debandra Nath Tagore and Sharda Devi. He started writing poems at the age of eight. He wrote many poems, short stories and dramas and songs. He was a great composer and wrote the National Anthem of our country. He received his Nobel Prize in the year 1913 for 'Gitanjali'. In the year 1901 he established the Brahmacharya Ashram at Santiniketan in West Bengal, which later became Viswa Bharti University. He loved the state of Tripura and the King much, so he visited the state many times. He also wrote ashram in the name of the king of Tripura. He has in his record 2232 songs, 165 short stories, 12 Novels, 36 Dramas and more than ten thousand poems. On 1941 he left for divine abode but the spirit of the world poet Rabindra Nath Tagore will live forever in our soil.
