

Essay on Rabindranath Tagore

Rabindranath Tagore was a great Indian poet. He was born on 07th May 1861 in Jorasanka, Kolkata. His full name was Rabindranath Thakur. His father's name was Debendranath Tagore and his mother's name was Sarada Devi. The author of the national anthem of India, Jana,Gana,Mana, the great poet, and the first Indian to be awarded the Nobel Prize, Rabindranath Tagore was a great poet with a remarkable talent. Rabindranath Tagore ji has also made his unique contribution in the field of education. He believed that education is the only medium through which the picture of the country can be changed. The whole life of Rabindranath Tagore was full of meditation and penance. As literature and art influenced him, simplicity started coming into his life. Gurudev Rabindranath Tagore ji was an infinite priest of humanity. In his view, man is a unique creation of the creator. Writing in his native Bengal, his continued success in writing enabled him to become a renowned voice of India's Spiritual Heritage. He was a great poet but also a patriot who always believed in the unity of life and its expression. Through his writings, he tried to bring people very close to unite them in Love, Peace, and Brotherhood. Rabindranath Tagore passed away on 07th August 1941. But still, his writings in the form of poetries and essays settled in the minds of the people.
